Earth Day Trout Stocking

Mr. Fedak and students from his Environmental Science class at Warren Area High School stocked young trout in Hatch Run on Earth Day. A representative from PBS was on hand to film the event, after interviewing students in the classroom.



A note from Mr. Fedak:

“The whole program was made possible with the help (and grant money) from the local Trout Unlimited group. The trout were raised from eyed eggs to the size at release in a 55 gallon tank in my classroom. Students helped to clean the tank and feed the fish. During the course of the year, the trout were used as a practical, real life example of various concepts in 5 curricular classes. We released them yesterday to celebrate Earth Day. PBS contacted me earlier about filming for Pennsylvania Greenlife, which airs in September and my students and the trout will be featured in around a 5 minute segment in one of the ½ hour shows.”
