Application Deadline: April 28, 2024

PA Council of Trout Unlimited (PATU) is pleased to announce that grant funding is available to teachers and program partners that are currently participating in the Trout in the Classroom (TIC) program and those wishing to start a new TIC program.

	About the Trout in the Classroom Grant Program
What?	 PATU can provide: Up to \$1,000 in funding for aquarium equipment and supplies, fishing and fly-tying equipment and supplies, TIC curriculum support materials, and release day/field trip expenses* (transportation and substitute teacher costs). Replacement filters and chillers for existing programs. Chillers for starting a new program (Grantee will be responsible for purchasing other startup materials and supplies.) *Hatchery field trips will not be funded.
Grantee Conditions	 Applicant must have attended a TIC training workshop in the past or must attend one of the TIC trainings offered this year. Applicant must utilize grant funds to continue and/or improve a current TIC program or start a new program. Teacher must complete required PA Fish & Boat Commission forms (TIC registration and end-of-year report).

April 28, 2024	Online grant application and budget form must be completed by 11:59 PM.
May 2024	Grant awards announced and checks mailed.
April 24, 2024 June 26, 2024	Trout in the Classroom Teacher Trainings
August 21, 2024 August 28, 2024	*Please note: If you have not attended TIC training in the past, you must attend to be eligible for a grant. You only need to attend one of the training dates.
August 30, 2024	End-of-Year Report for 2023-24 and Registration for 2024-25 must be completed.
September 2024	Chillers and filters will be sent directly to schools.
